The objective of the lecture series was to provide insights on research proposal writing to get funding in different research areas. Dr. C. Bharatiraja, **Head- Centre of Electric Mobility (EMC) DST PURSE Coordinator**, SRM Institute of Science and Technology, Chennai was the resource person.

Dr. C. Bharatiraja discussed various R&D areas & how to select research project topic, components of a research project proposal, common errors in writing project proposal, DST, DRDO and CSIR Project proposal. He started the session by explaining the basic information for grant application in EVs For competitive environment. The importance of quality of the proposal that contributes a lot to the evaluation outcome also been discussed. Furthermore, the important areas where we can focus research such as multi-disciplinary research, how to select a research topic, components of research proposal, social impact of the proposal and common errors in writing the proposal were discussed. The audience was eager to learn the various steps to write DST, DRDO and CSIR Project proposal. He shared his insights about the reviewers’ parameters on the evaluation of a DST, DRDO and CSIR project proposal. He also shared the various government funding schemes with a sample proposal. About 68 participants had attended the lecture which was useful and very informative to all attendees.




